

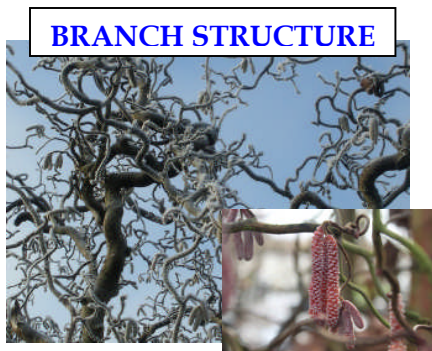
# YEAR-ROUND INTEREST

*Plants with year-round interest earn this recognition because there is something special for each season. However, when all the leaves have gone and the days get shorter and shorter, these plants are especially valuable in the landscape pleasing the eye with stunning peeling bark, brilliant berries or, surprise flowers bringing colour to the winter landscape!*

**Prunus x 'Snowgoose'** (Pictured at right.) *Prunus serrula* 'Tibetica' is used as a standard understock, adding beautiful, peeling bark, to top-grafted ornamental cherry trees such as 'Snowgoose' and 'Incisa Little Twist'.

**BRANCH STRUCTURE**

**Corylus avellana 'Contorta'** (Pictured at left) is showing its very curly branches beautifully with a fresh coat of hoar frost. Catkins add interest. The cultivar 'Red Majestic' has purple foliage and pinkish-red catkins!



**WINTER FLOWERS**

**Hamamelis intermedia 'Jelena'** (Pictured at right) Winter flowering. Witchhazels bloom at the same time the previous years seeds mature. *Hamamelis vernalis* cultivars bloom Sept to Dec while all others bloom in the dark of winter with the promise of spring. **BERRIES**

**Viburnum davidii** (Pictured at left) and **Viburnum tinus 'Gwenllian'** (Pictured at right) have, like most *Viburnum* species & cultivars, brightly coloured (blue) berries, late winter /early spring flowers; most have evergreen foliage



**UNUSUAL**

**Heptacodium miconioides** (Pictured at left (bark) and right (fruit)) Interesting details: Deeply veined foliage, summer flowers(white), most unusual fruit resembling flowers (red) and peeling (string) bark.
